WHAT TO EXPECT

Precalculus with Trigonometry is a college preparatory mathematics course. Your enrollment in this course indicates a commitment to think, work, and produce at the college preparatory level. This course is intended to prepare you for the demands of college-level mathematics. The course is taught with the expectation that students plan to attend college and will most likely need Calculus for their major. Successful completion of the course will provide a broad foundation in mathematics. This course assumes recall of algebra, geometry, and introductory trigonometry. You are expected to bring a graphing calculator with you daily. You will learn to use this technology as a tool. Your understanding of concepts and skills will be assessed both with and without the calculator.

- Conic Sections
- Sequence and Series
